THE SA CHEFS' JUDGES COURSE

To be apart of the Judges course a chef, must be a member in good standing with SA Chefs, and to continue to hold such license the chef must continue to be a member in good standing in the course there will be information regarding South African culinary competitions to ensure a fair and diverse judging panel at all competitions.

JUDGING LICENCE

Judges' licenses are valid for five years within South Africa

After four years, the SA Chefs office will send out a reminder for renewal!

If a renewal seminar is not attended during the following year, the judge will be removed from the list of certified judges until such point that they have participated in a SA Chefs judge's course

WORLDCHEFS LICENCE

In order to qualify for a WORLDCHEFS judges license you would have needed to hold a national license (SA Chefs) and fulfil the necessary obligations and criteria set out by WORLDCHEFS

Administration costs

Payment of the facilitator

Certificates for the candidates

Flights or transport (if 12 candidates attend)

Digital judging access and certification

Application fees for judging

Certification process and listing with in South Africa



HOSTING EXPECTATIONS

At minimal and up for discussion, the host must provide for or arrange

Reasonable accommodation

Breakfast and dinner

2 beverages per meal period

Transport cost if minimal numbers not attained

Transfers to venues

Venue with requirements

MINIMUM NUMBERS

Should the minimum number per course not be achieved the accommodation, transportation, and board of the facilitator needs to be covered by host
