# Entering Singapore

To ensure a smooth journey, travellers seeking to enter Singapore should comply with the Entry and Public Health requirements listed below.

## 1) General Entry Requirements

### 1a) Immigration Requirements

To enter Singapore, travellers must meet the following immigration requirements:

#### i) Passport Validity

Have minimum 6-month passport validity if you are not a Singapore passport holder

#### ii) Visa

Short term travellers holding a passport or travel document from a visa-required country/region must apply for a Visa. Visa-required travellers can use the Visa-Free Transit Facility for stay of less than 96 hours in Singapore, if eligible

**Currently South African Citizens do not require a travel Visa to enter Singapore \*\* subject to change**

#### iii) Security and Immigration Processes on Arrival

Ensure that you do not bring prohibited items into Singapore. Familiarise yourself with immigration/customs clearance procedures, including whether you are eligible for automated clearance. Short-Term travellers should have sufficient cash and proof of onward travel (tickets, visas), and ensure that you do not stay beyond your visit pass validity. You may retrieve your e-Pass after arrival using the e-Pass Enquiry Portal or check your visit pass validity using the visit pass validity tool.

### 1b) SG Arrival Card (SGAC)

All travellers must fill in the SGAC declaration up to 3 days before arrival

Only Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and Long-Term Pass Holders entering via land checkpoints do not need to fill in the SGAC

### 1c) Post-arrival Advisories

Short Term Visitors

Visitors who wish to stay beyond the period of stay granted can apply for a visit pass extension online using the e-Service. Applications are subject to approval.

Travellers on short-term visit pass are also not permitted to engage in any business, professional or paid employment activities when in Singapore. Overstaying is also a punishable offence in Singapore.

## COVID-19 Vaccination for Permanent Residence and Long-Term Pass

Up-to-date COVID-19 vaccination is required for new Permanent Residence, Long-Term Pass and Work Pass applications, as well as the renewal of Work Permit holders in the construction, marine and process sectors or residing in dormitories. Refer to MOH's FAQs on how to keep your COVID-19 vaccination status up-to-date in Singapore. Work pass holders should refer to MOM's website for details on vaccination requirements, and are advised to take their COVID-19 boosters before entering Singapore to avoid delays for their pass issuance. From 1 Apr 2023, persons who recently recovered from COVID-19 will no longer enjoy temporary exemption from COVID-19 vaccination requirements.

## 2) Public Health Requirements

To avoid tests and quarantine, travellers must fulfil the public health requirements below. Travellers who cannot meet the public health requirements and refuse any test(s) and/or quarantine may be turned away from Singapore.

### 2a) Yellow Fever Requirements

Produce an International Certificate of Vaccination for Yellow Fever, if you have visited any country at risk of Yellow Fever transmission in the six (6) days prior to arrival in Singapore.

Travellers must serve quarantine for six (6) days from date of departure from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission if they cannot meet the requirement. Quarantine also applies to those who are ineligible to receive the vaccination e.g., children aged one year and below and individuals with contraindications, and travellers whose yellow fever vaccination certificate has yet to become valid.

### 2b) COVID-19 Requirements

There are no longer any COVID-19 measures for travellers arriving in Singapore from 13 Feb 2023, regardless of vaccination status or traveller profile.

# Getting Around Singapore

## Public Transport

Singapore's MRT (Mass Rapid Transit) and bus systems have an extensive network of routes that will help you zip around the city. The bus routes are also some of the most scenic, allowing you to indulge in the lush greenery and beautiful architecture of our 'city in a garden'. All public buses are wheelchair accessible and open strollers are allowed. Please approach our friendly bus captains if you need assistance. Do take note that you may be required to fold your stroller if the bus has too many passengers. You can refer to the the SBS Transit, SMRT, Go-Ahead Singapore, and Tower Transit Singapore websites for more information and guidelines.



## Taxi or ride-hailing Apps



Taxis are comfortable and especially handy if you want to go to places not accessible by the bus or MRT. Cabs here are metered, but there may be surcharges depending on when, where and which company's taxi you board. To get a rough idea of the final fare, check with the driver on the surcharges and ask for a receipt at the end of the trip. You can hail a taxi by the roadside at most places, or by queuing for one at a taxi stand, which you'll find at most malls, hotels and attractions. Alternatively, you may use one of the ride-hailing applications available in Singapore to book a ride from your preferred pick-up point to your desired destination. Some options available include Grab, Gojek, Ryde and TADA.

## Bicycle

Cycling around our sunny island is a great way to get your dose of Vitamin D and enjoy the green spaces that dot our city. Singapore boasts a well-connected network of cycling paths, and you can rent shared bicycles from licensed operators. Feel free to bring your foldable bike onboard our trains and buses, but check if they're too bulky.



## Singapore Visitor Centre



If you need assistance or have any queries, drop by one of any of the seven Singapore Visitor Centres.

The visitor centres boast a range of helpful services and information. You'll be able to plan your itinerary, get tips on must-see attractions, purchase tickets for sightseeing, book accommodation and even pick up a souvenir (or two).
